of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part
and George H. Gilmore of the second part:

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration of
the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his
 heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate in the
 County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:
 The North West Quarter of Section Thirty three (33) in Township fourteen (14)
 Range twenty (20) with the appurtenances and all the estate title and
 interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said J. Ch.
 Green and May S. Green do hereby covenant and agree that at the
 delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above
 granted and seised of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
