This Indenture Made this Third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between Abraham H. Daniels and Hester Daniels his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Thomas Johnston of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy Five (\$75.00) Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit Being Acre number Thirty five (35) of Addition number Eleven (11) according to the Plat of additions to North Lawrence filed in the office of Register of Deeds for Douglas County April 1866 with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of seventy five (75) Dollars according to the terms of a certain promissory note made by the parties of the first part hereto dated January 3rd 1883 for seventy five dollars with eight percent interest per annum payable in one year from date and payable to the order of the party of the second part hereto

And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified But if default be made in said payment or any part thereof as provided then this conveyance shall become due
