All the land lying East of the track of the Kansas Pacific Railway Company situate in the South half of the East half of the Southwest quarter of Section Eighteen (18) in Township Twelve (12) of Range Twenty (20) of the Government Survey containing Thirteen and one half (13 1/2) acres more or less

To Have and to Hold the same with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever
