Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all the following described piece and parcel of land lying and situate in the City of Lawrence County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit

The North half of Lot numbered Forty Three (43) on Massachusetts Street in said City of Lawrence Douglas County State of Kansas

Do have and to hold the same with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever And the said John B. Haskell and Mary E. B. Haskell his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seised of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will Warrant and Defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever against all persons lawfully claiming the same

Provided Always and these presents are upon this express condition that whereas the said John B. Haskell and Mary E. B. Haskell his wife are justly indebted unto the said John E. Myers in the principal sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars lawful money of the United States of America being for a loan thereof on the day and date hereof made by the said John E. Myers to the said John B. Haskell and Mary E. B. Haskell his wife and secured to be paid by a certain promissory note of the said John B. Haskell and Mary E. B. Haskell his wife bearing even date herewith payable to the order of the said John E. Myers five years from the date thereof at the office of A. H. Foote in the City of Lawrence and State of Kansas with interest at the rate
