This Indenture made this 14th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between Adam Tuttle and his wife Harriet Tuttle of Marion Township in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Jennie Barlow of Gauntlett Mass. of the second part

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and Twenty Five Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit

The South half (1/2) of the North West quarter (1/4) of Section No. Fourteen (14) in Town No. Fourteen (14) South of Range No. Eighteen (18) East and also six (6) acres in the South East corner of the North half of same quarter section Town and Range and containing in all Eighty six (86) acres more or less also the South half of the North East quarter (1/4) of same section No. Fourteen (14) Town No. Fourteen (14) and Range Eighteen (18) less Twenty four and 1/2 acres (24 1/2) in South part of said land last described, intending hereby to convey in all One hundred and Forty one and 85/100 (141 85/100) acres more or less with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of

the said parties of the first part therein and the said Adam Tuttle and Harriet Tuttle do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance free and clear of all incumbrances

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five hundred and Twenty Five Dollars (\$525⁰⁰) in five years after date hereof according to the terms of one principal note for the sum of said Five hundred and Twenty Five Dollars together with ten interest coupons thereto attached for Twenty six and 25/100 Dollars each this day executed and delivered by the said Adam Tuttle and Harriet Tuttle to the said party of the second part and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified But if default be made in such payment or any part thereof or interest thereon or the tax
