 thousand eight hundred and eighty three between Matilda C. Weeks

 his wife Ella M. Hodgman and Samuel C. her husband and Joseph H.
 Weeks & Mary L. Weeks both unmarried all being the sole heirs of Robert
 C. Weeks dec. late of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of
 the first part and Pauline Weeks of the second part
 Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration
 of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second
 part heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land
 situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described
 as follows to wit
