This Indenture Made this Seventeenth day of July in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between
Bertha C. Ross and William A. Ross her husband of Lawrence
in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part
and M. H. Moore of the second part

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration
of the sum of Eleven hundred and Twenty Five Dollars to them
duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage
to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever
all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas
and State of Kansas described as follows to wit

The East Eight (8) acres of the North Ten (10) acres of the East Thirty
(30) acres of the South half (1/2) of the North East quarter (1/4) of Section
number Thirty five (35) Town Number Twelve (12) of Range Number
Nineteen (19) also Lots numbered Sixty five (65) Sixty seven (67) Sixty
nine (69) and Seventy one (71) on New Jersey Street in the City of
Lawrence County of Douglas and State of Kansas
with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the
said parties of the first part therein and the said Bertha C. Ross
and William A. Ross do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery
hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and
seized of a good indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and
clear of all incumbrances

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of
the sum of Eleven hundred and Twenty Five Dollars (\$1125.00) in
five years after date hereof with interest thereon at the rate of ten
per cent per annum payable annually the first interest payment
to become due Nov. 1st 1883 and all subsequent interest payments to
become due on the first day of Nov. in each year except the last
which will be due July 17th. 1888 said first parties hereby reserve
the right to pay the whole or any part of said principal at any
