This Indenture Made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between George W. Thomson and Jane Thomson his wife in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Hannah Eyer of the second part

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit

Commencing at a point on the North line of the South East quarter of Section Nine (9) Township Fourteen (14) Range Nineteen (19) Sixty two (62) rods East of the North East corner of the same tract situated in the North West corner of said quarter Section and heretofore sold and conveyed to Moses Flory by Abraham Flory thence directly South 129 rods thence West 42 rods thence North 9 rods thence West 20 rods to the East line of the ten (10) acres of land on the West side of said quarter Section formerly conveyed to and owned by Eli Flory thence North on the East line of said ten (10) acres and the line is now lying directly North of same and formerly conveyed to and owned by Abraham Flory to a point on the South line of said eight (8) acre tract (where said line produced North would intersect said South line) thence East to the South East corner of said eight (8) acre tract thence North to the place of beginning containing 51 acres more or less

with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein And the said George W. Thomson and Jane Thomson his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One Thousand Dollars payable in 10 equal installments of \$100 each on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1884 every year thereafter till paid interest payable annually at 6 percent according to the terms of 10 certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by the said George W. Thomson and wife to the said party of the second part and this
