This Indenture, Made this 16th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between Lemuel King and Anna King his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Thomas Perrin of the second part: Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred + Fifty (\$550⁰⁰) Dollars to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: The North Thirty (30) Acres of North East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of North West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No Twenty four (24) Township No Twelve (12) South of Range No Nineteen (19) in Douglas County Kansas with the appurtenances, and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Lemuel King and Anna King his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of one certain promissory note of Five Hundred + Fifty (\$550⁰⁰) being part of purchase
