This Indenture, Made this 8th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between John Chilcote and Mary A. Chilcote his wife of Clinton in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and F. F. Stewart of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: The South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North West quarter of Section Twenty Three (23) and the North
