This Indenture, Made this Third day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between Andrew J. Griffin and Mary C. Griffin his wife Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and W. H. Elwell of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred  $\frac{7}{10}$  Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: Lot Number Nine (9) and Twenty (20) in Block Eleven (11) Barnes 2<sup>d</sup> addition to the City Lawrence County and State aforesaid with the appurtenances and all the estate, title, and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Andrew J. Griffin does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage, to secure the payment of the sum of Eight Hundred  $\frac{7}{10}$  Dollars payable One year from date at the National Bank of Lawrence Kansas with interest at the rate of Nine per cent per annum according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Andrew J. Griffin and Mary C. Griffin to the said party of the second part: and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified.
