

This Indenture, Made this 23rd day of October in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty
three between Fremont Gilges and his wife Anna Bell
Gilges of Willow Springs in the County of Douglas and State
of Kansas of the first part, and Mary A. Lewis of the second
part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration
of the sum of Five hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the
said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever
all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: The
East half of the South West quarter of Section Thirty three (33)
Township Fourteen (14) Range Nineteen (9) with the appurtenances
and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the
first part therein. And the said Fremont Gilges does hereby
covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof is the lawful
owner of the premises above granted, and seyed of a good and
indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all
incumbrances.
