

This Indenture, Made this twenty seventh day of December in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
eighty three between Mary Ann Davis and James W. Davis  
her husband of the County of Franklin and State of Kansas  
of the first part and Walker M. Yeatman of Douglas County  
Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in  
consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to them  
duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell  
and mortgage to the said party of the second part his  
heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of  
land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas  
described as follows, to wit, Lots Nos. (11) eleven (12) twelve (13)  
thirteen and (14) fourteen in addition No (6) Six in that  
part of the City of Lawrence known formerly as North  
Lawrence according to the recorded plat of said North  
Lawrence: being the premises this day conveyed by the  
said Walker M. Yeatman and wife to the said Mary Ann  
Davis. This Mortgage being given to secure the unpaid  
portion of the purchase money with the appurtenances  
and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties  
of the first part therein. And the said Mortgagors do  
hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof  
they are the lawful owners of the premises above  
granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of  
inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.  
This Grant is intended as a Mortgage, to secure the payment  
of the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600<sup>00</sup>) according to  
the terms of two certain promissory notes this day  
executed and delivered by the said Mary Ann Davis and  
James W. Davis to the said party of the second part for  
(\$300<sup>00</sup>) three hundred dollars each payable to the order  
of said Walker M. Yeatman with interest from date  
at the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum payable semi-  
annually one payable on or before the twenty seventh  
day of December A.D. 1885 and the other on or before the  
twenty seventh day of December A.D. 1887 in manner as  
in said notes expressed and this conveyance shall be  
void if such payment be made as herein specified.
