13. Ukrainian Registration Law

This Indenture, Made this twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between Louisa Vitt and Candelin Vitt her husband of Eudora in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Charles Dwyer of Eudora in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part ~~for~~
and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred
Dollars to them duly paid, to receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all
that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to-wit:
The South Half of the South East Quarter of Section four (4)
Township fourteen (14) Range twenty one (21) containing (80)
eighty acres more or less with the appurtenances
and all the estate, title and interest of the said
parties of first part therein. This Grant is intended
as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of
Four Hundred (400) Dollars, according to the terms of a
certain promissory note as follows: \$400⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Endora Kansas
November 24th 1883. Five years after date we promise to
pay to the order of Charles Durr the sum of Four
Hundred Dollars at the office of Charles Durr in Endora
Ks. Value received with interests at ten per cent per
annum after date until paid interests payable semi-
annually.

And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in said payment, or any part thereof, as provided then this conveyance shall become absolute and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal and
