Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of (\$2000) Two Thousand Dollars to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to wit: The South Half of the South West Quarter of Section No. Eight (8) and the South Half of the North Half of South West Quarter of Section No. Eight (8) all in Township No. Fourteen (14) South of Range No. Twenty one (21) East of the 6th principal Meridians with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Henry Rensch does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.
