This Indenture, Made this 14th day of January in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four
between Bartholomew Bates and Anna his wife of the
County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and
Mrs Isabelle W. Merry of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in
consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to them
duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and mortgage to the said party of the second part her
heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of
land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas
described as follows to wit: North East quarter of the North
East quarter of Section Twenty Nine (29) Township Fourteen (14)
Range Nineteen (19) containing 40 acres more or less with
the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest
of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said
Bartholomew Bates does hereby covenant and agree that
at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises
above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate
of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.
This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the

Payment of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars five years
after date with interest payable annually at ten per cent
per annum according to the terms of one certain promissory
note this day executed and delivered by the said Bartholomew
Bates and Anna his wife to the said party of the
second part; and this conveyance shall be void if
such payment be made as herein specified. But if default
be made in such payment, or any part thereof or
interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is
