This Indenture, Made this 25th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighty Four between Diley Thomas and Addison Thomas her husband of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and D. G. Headley of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

Lot One Hundred and Three (103) on New Jersey Street in the City of Lawrence County of Douglas and State of Kansas with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
