This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of February
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 eighty four between John J. Jones of Lawrence in the
 County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and
 Robert Owens of Jasper County Missouri of the second part

Witnesseth That the said party of the first part in
 consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to him
 duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 has sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell
 and mortgage to the said party of the second part his
 heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of
 land situated in the County of Douglas and State of
 Kansas described as follows to wit;

So much of lot number (46) forty six on Massachusetts
 Street in the City of Lawrence as is described as follows
 beginning at the South West corner of said lot thence
 running east (17) one hundred and seventeen feet to an
 alley thence North on said alley (60) fifty feet to Henry
 Street thence West on said lot 23 1/2 feet thence South-
 (25) twenty five feet thence West 73 1/2 feet to said
 Massachusetts Street thence South (25) twenty five feet
 on said Massachusetts Street to place of beginning contain-
 ing 35 1/2 square feet being the premises this day
 conveyed by the said Robert Owens to the said John J. Jones
 this mortgage being given to secure the unpaid portion of
 the purchase money with the appurtenances and all
 the estate title and interest of the said parties of the
 first part therein. And the said John J. Jones does hereby
 covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is
 the lawful owner of the premises above granted and
 seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
 therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the
 payment of the sum of One Thousand Dollars according
 to the terms of two certain promissory notes of even date
 herewith for five hundred dollars each made by the
 said John J. Jones payable to Robert Owens or order with
 interest from date at the rate of five per cent per annum
 one payable on or before the first day of March A. D. 1885
 and the other payable on or before the first day March
