This Indenture made this fifth day of March in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 eighty four between Hugh Cameron (single) of the
 County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part
 and Mary J. Smith of Little Rock Arkansas of the
 second part;

Witnesseth - That the said party of the first part in
 consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to
 him duly paid the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged hath sold and by these presents doth
 grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party
 of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that
 tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas
 and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:
 Commencing at the North East corner of Lot No. Five (5)
 on the West side of Bridge Street in Block No. Thirteen
 (13) in that part of the City of Lawrence known formerly
 as North Lawrence; thence running West one hundred
 and ten (10) feet to the North West corner of said Lot No.
 5 on the West side of said Block 13. thence South with the
 West side of said Block No. 13 which is also the East side
 of Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence (formerly
 North Lawrence) to the bank of the Kansas River, thence
 easterly along the bank of said river to Bridge Street
 thence North along West side of Bridge Street to the place of
 beginning, being fractional Lot No. Five (5) on the West
 side of Bridge Street in said North Lawrence according
 to a plat of North Lawrence and Additions made by
 A. D. Searl with the appurtenances and all the
 estate title and interest of the said party of the first
 part therein. And the said Hugh Cameron doth
 hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof
 he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted
 and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of
 inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances
 This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the

 one year from the date hereof with interest from date
 until paid at the rate of ten (10) per cent per annum
