This Indenture made this 8th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four between Florence B. Kiddleston and Jas. J. Kiddleston her husband of Eudora in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and M. D. Greenlee of Eudora in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part;

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and 00 Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit;
