This Indenture made this 18 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four between Adora Bussel and Lewis B. Bussel her husband of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Sarah Ann Whitnereck of the second part;

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for consideration of the sum of (\$300.⁰⁰) Three Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit;

Lot number 12 Twelve in Block (8) eight on Indiana Street in Lanes First Addition to the City of Lawrence County and State aforesaid with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Adora Bussel and Lewis B. Bussel do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure payment of the sum of (\$300.⁰⁰) Three Hundred Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note of even date this day executed by the said Adora
