This indenture, Made this First day of March in the year
of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty four
by and between Ezekiel S. Clark and Marobia M. Clark his
wife of the County of Franklin and State of Kansas, party of
the first part, and Timothy B. Sweet of the County of Shawnee
and State of Kansas, Trustee, party of the second part (and in
case of the death, absence, or removal from said County of
Shawnee, refusal or inability to act of the said party of the
second part, then George M. Noble, of said County of Shawnee
shall be, and is hereby appointed and made successor in
trust to said party of the second part under this deed for
the purpose herein after expressed, with the same power and
authority as said Trustee) and E. W. Sheldon party of the
third part:

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration
of the debt and trust herein after mentioned and created, and
of the sum of one dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell,
convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part
and to his successors in trust, forever all of the following
described premises, situated in the County of Franklin and
State of Kansas, and more particularly bounded and described
as follows to wit: The East half of the North east quarter of
Section No Twenty (20) in Township No Fifteen (15) South of Range
No. Eighteen (18) East of the Sixth P. M. containing Eighty (80)
acres, more or less, also the following described premises
situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit:
The South-half of the South-west quarter of Section No Sixteen
(16) in Township No Fifteen (15) South of Range No Eighteen (18)
East of the sixth P. M. containing Eighty (80) acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the said described premises, together
with all the rights, privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises, in any wise appertaining or belonging.
