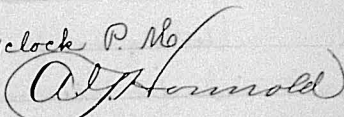

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$100 one hundred Dollars to him duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant, bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: Commencing twenty (20) Rods East of the south west corner of the north west quarter of the south west tract quarter of Sec.
