Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all of the following described piece and parcel of land lying and situate in the City of Lawrence County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit; The North half of Lot No. Eleven (11) on Pinckney Street in the City of Lawrence according to the recorded plat of said City. To have and to hold the same with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said David Burr and Harriet Elizabeth Burr do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery thereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns
