This Indenture made this first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four between P. A. Dolbee (an unmarried man) of _____ in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Theodore Pochler of the second part;

Witnesseth- That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand (\$7000) Dollars to him duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

The undivided one half of the following, The South West quarter of Section Thirty six, Township Thirteen, Range Eighteen and the South half and the North-East quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Thirty six, Township Thirteen Range Eighteen and North East quarter of North East quarter of South-West quarter of Section One Town fourteen Range Eighteen and fractional North-East quarter of Section One, Town fourteen Range Eighteen and fractional North-West quarter of Section One, Town fourteen, range eighteen and North-half of West sixty acres of South-East quarter Section One, Town Fourteen Range Eighteen and East ninety eight acres of fractional North-East quarter of Section two Town Fourteen, Range Eighteen and the North east quarter of the South east quarter of Section Two, Township Fourteen, Range eighteen all in said County of Douglas and State of Kansas with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said P. A. Dolbee does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of seven Thousand Dollars (\$7000) with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum.
