thereon from the date thereof until paid, according to the terms of said note and coupon thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be void if such

payment be made as in said note and coupon thereto attached, and as is hereinafter specified. And the said part is of the first part hereby agree

to pay all taxes assessed on said premises before any penalties or costs shall accrue on account thereof, and to keep the said premises insured in favor of

the said mortgagee, in the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS,

in some insurance company satisfactory to said mortgagee, in default whereof the said mortgagee may pay the taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs and insure, and insure the same at the expense of the part is of the first part, and the expense of such taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs and insurance, shall from the payment thereof, be and become an additional lien under this mortgage upon the above described premises, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10 per cent, per annum.
