COUPON MORTGAGE—WALK BROS. & CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN., NO. 1241.

This Indenture, Made this Third day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Five between Catherine Benson and O. P. Benson her husband of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and

W. F. Samlin of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Sixty DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at the North East Corner of the South East Quarter of Section Thirty Two (32) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twentieth (20) East of 6th P.M.
Thence West 100 rods Thence South 16 rods Thence East 100 rods
Thence North 16 rods to place of beginning Containing 10 acres more or less

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of of the first part therein. And the said Catherine Benson and O. P. Benson

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended as a MORTGAGE to secure the payment of the sum of One Hundred and Sixty Dollars, according to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed by the said Catherine Benson and O. P. Benson to the said part y of the second part. Said note being given for the sum of One Hundred and Sixty Dollars, dated June 3rd 1905 due and payable in 4 years from date hereof, with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid, according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as in said note and coupons thereto attached, and as is hereinafter specified. And the said part of of the first part hereby agree to pay all taxes assessed on said premises before any penalties or costs shall accrue on account thereof, and to keep the said premises insured in favor of the said mortgagee, in the sum of _____ DOLLARS.

In some insurance company satisfactory to said mortgagee, in default whereof the said mortgagee may pay the taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs, and insure the same at the expense of the parties of the first part, and the expense of such taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs and insurance, shall from the payment thereof, be and become an additional lien under this mortgage upon the above described premises, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest interest thereon, or the taxes assessed on said premises, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole principal of said note, and interest thereon, and all taxes and accruing penalties and interest and costs thereon remaining unpaid or which may have been paid by the part y of the second part, and all sums paid by the part y of the second part for insurance, shall be due and payable or not at the option of the part y of the second part; and it shall be lawful for the part y of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the part y of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due or to become due according to the conditions of this instrument, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part y making such sale on demand, to the said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
