the second part. Witnesseth, That the party of the first
part, for a good and valuable consideration to him in
hand paid by the said party of the second part, has
sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed, and does
hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey to the party of
the second part a certain mortgage bearing date the

payment of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000),
