

present does grant, bargain, sell, set off, release, convey and confirm unto the Commonwealth Trust Company, as Trustee, as aforesaid, and into its successors and assigns, all the telephone plant and system of the Telephone Company in the States of Missouri and Kansas, and all its other property, right, franchises, privileges and immunities of every character and description, whether in action or possession, wheresoever situated, which it now owns or is entitled to, or which it may hereafter acquire or become entitled to in said States, or in any other State, territory or place; the purpose hereof being to convey and transfer under this deed of trust, or mortgage, to the said Trustee, everything of value which the said Telephone Company now owns or is entitled to, or may hereafter own, or become entitled to, wherever and whatever it may be, including, among other things, the following telephone lines and properties which have already been constructed, or are now in the course of construction, to-wit:-

The following lines and properties in the States of Kansas and Missouri:-

- (1) A telephone line from the corporate limits of the city of Kansas City, in the State of Kansas, through or adjacent to the cities or towns of Edwardsville and Bonner Springs, in Wyandotte County, Kansas; Linwood, in Leavenworth County, Kansas; Lawrence, in Douglas County, Kansas, and Topeka, in Shawnee County, Kansas, a distance of seventy and one-half (70 1/2) miles, forty poles to the mile, equipped with one (1) ten-pin cross arm, carrying three (3) No. 10 B. & S. gauge copper circuits, extending from said Kansas City, Kansas, to Topeka, Kansas, and (1) one No. 10 B. & S. gauge copper circuit from said Kansas City, Kansas, to Edwardsville and Bonner Springs, Kansas.
- (2) A telephone line from the corporate limits of said Kansas City, Kansas, through or adjacent to the cities or towns of Lansing and Linwood and Easton, in Leavenworth County, Kansas; Potter, Atchison and Doniphan, in Atchison County, Kansas; Brewer, Troy, Wathena and Elwood, in Doniphan County, Kansas and from Elwood to the corporate limits of the city of St. Joseph, in the State of Missouri, a distance of eighty (80) miles,
