(3) A telephone line from the corporate limits of the city of Kansas City, in the State of Missouri, through or adjacent to the cities or towns of Merriam, Lenexa, Olathe and Spring Hill in Johnson County, Kansas; Ellendale and Paola, in Miami County, Kansas, to Ottawa, in Franklin County, Kansas, a distance of seventy-eight (78) miles, forty poles to the mile, equipped with one (1) 10-pin cross arm carrying seven (7) No. 10 B. & S. copper circuits from said Kansas City to Olathe; six (6) No. 10 copper circuits from Olathe to Paola, and five (5) No. 10 copper circuits from Paola to Ottawa.

(4) A telephone line from the corporate limits of the city of Kansas City in the State of Missouri, through or adjacent to the cities or towns of Independence, Little Blue, Lees Summit and Truman, in Jackson County, Missouri; Pleasant Hill and Strausburg, in Cass County, Missouri; Kingsville, Golden, Center View, Warrensburg, Monticello and Knobnoster, in Johnson County, Missouri; Summit and Dresden in Pettis County, Missouri, to Sedalia, in Pettis County, Missouri, a distance of one hundred (100) miles, forty poles to the mile, equipped with three (3) ten pin cross arms, from said Kansas City to Independence, carrying fourteen (14) No. 10 and one (1) No. 8 B. & S. copper circuits, and two (2) 10-pin cross arms from Independence to junction west of Pleasant Hill, carrying nine (9) No. 10 B. & S. and one (1) No. 8 B. & S. copper circuits, and from junction west of Pleasant Hill to Warrensburg, carrying three (3) No. 10 B. & S. copper circuits and one (1) No. 10 B. & S. copper circuit, and from Warrensburg to Sedalia, carrying two (2) No. 10 B. & S. gauge copper circuits and one (1) No. 8 B. & S. gauge copper circuit.

(5) Also a telephone line from a point on said Sedalia line about three (3) miles west of Pleasant Hill, to the corporate limits of the City of Harrisonville, in Cass County, Missouri, a distance of about eight (8) miles, forty poles to the mile, equipped with one (1) 10-pin cross arm, carrying four (4) No. 10 B. & S. gauge copper circuits.
