Bowercock of same city in the County of Jackson in State of Missouri, Party of the Second Part.

Witnesseth, whereas, the party of the first part under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Kansas, has hitherto erected and has now in full operation, works for the manufacture and supply of electric current to the inhabitants of the said City of Lawrence, and has already a large amount of copper wire for conveying electric current throughout said city, and has hitherto erected and are now in full operation, buildings, works and appliances for the manufacture and generation of light, heat and power by electricity in the said City of Lawrence - and has already a large number of poles, wires, dynamos and other appliances constructed, erected, laid and placed for conveying said electric light to the inhabitants throughout said city, and

whereas, the aforesaid electric light works are not of sufficient capacity to fully supply the demands of the patrons and consumers of electric light & power, and whereas, a large portion of the fixtures and other appliances of said electric light works for generating light, heat and power are in need of improvements and repair, and
