

Know all men by these Presents That for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty-seven and  $\frac{7}{10}$  Dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, Fanny Bergman of the City of Lawrence of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas do hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign and set over to Ralph Bergman of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, a certain Indenture of Mortgage, together with the note therein referred to, executed by Fda H. Haworth and E. Haworth, her husband, on 11<sup>th</sup> May 1901 to one Mary T. Gleason on the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lots number One (1) and Sixteen (16) and the North two-thirds (2/3) of Lots numbers Two (2) and Fifteen (15) in Block number Ten (10) Babcock's Enlarged Addition to the City of Lawrence.

Said Mortgage was recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for said County of Douglas and State of Kansas, on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May A.D. 1901 at 11<sup>th</sup> o'clock A.M., in book 38 of mortgages at page 245.

And afterwards on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1902, on Paul R. Brooks, administrator of the estate of said Mary T. Gleason, then deceased, for value received, did assign and transfer said mortgage to the said Fanny Bergman, which said assignment was recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1902, in book 38 of mortgages abage 245, to have and to hold the said note and mortgage and the debt thereby secured, and all the interest conveyed by the said mortgage in and to the lands therein described, to the said Ralph Bergman his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever for his and their sole use and benefit.
