

Trust Company, as Trustee, as aforesaid, and unto its successors and assigns, all the Telephone plants and systems ~~of the~~ of the Telephone Company in said City of Lawrence, in said County of Douglas, and said State of Kansas, and all its other property, right, franchise, privileges and immunities, of every character and description, whether in action or possession, wheresoever situated, which it now owns, or is entitled to, or which it may hereafter acquire or become entitled to, in said City of Lawrence, in said County of Douglas, and in said State of Kansas, or any other state, territory or place; the purpose hereof being to convey and transfer under this deed of trust, or mortgage to said Trustee, every thing of value which the said Telephone Company now owns or is entitled to, or may hereafter own, or become entitled to, wherever and whatever it may be, including, among other things, the following lines and properties in said City of Lawrence, in said County of Douglas, in said State of Kansas, which have already been constructed or are now in the course of construction,

to-wit: Lot No. 37 on Vermont Street, in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and the two story fire proof building thereon. One Stromberg-Carlson multiple switch-boards, central energy lamp signal, equipped for one thousand (1000) lines, ultimate capacity, thirty-six hundred (3600) lines.

One thousand (1000) Stromberg-Carlson central energy telephones. Forty thousand, seven hundred and two (40,702) duct feet of conduit in the main line sections, thirty-five hundred and sixty-six (3566) duct feet in the laterals, a total of forty-four thousand, two hundred sixty-eight (44,268) duct feet in conduits, also five thousand and two (5,002) lineal feet of underground in the main line section, and eleven hundred and forty-two (1142) feet in the laterals, a total of six thousand one hundred and forty-four (6,144) feet.

Said underground work runs as follows:-

From the Central Station north on Vermont Street to Winthrop Street; thence east on Winthrop Street to the alley east of Massachusetts Street; also south from the Central Station on Vermont Street to Warren Street; thence east on Warren Street to the alley east of Massachusetts Street also west on Warren Street from Vermont Street to the alley west of Vermont Street; also south on Vermont Street from Warren Street to Quincy Street; thence east on Quincy Street to Massachusetts and thence south on Massachusetts Street to the alley south of Quincy Street.
