

This Indenture, Made this 28th day of August 1915, between W. W. Bromelsick - defendant of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and Lodge and Marmore Company of Marion County, in the State of Indiana, of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Seventy Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged does by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey, unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all the following-described Real Estate, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot number Four (4) Five (5) Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17) in Block number One Hundred and Seventy Nine (179) in the city of Endora, county and state aforesaid, To Have And To Hold The Same, Together, with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said W. W. Bromelsick has executed and delivered three certain promissory notes in writing to said parties of the second part, of which the following is a brief description:

One note dated July 1st, 1905, for \$120.00, due four months after date thereof, with interest thereof at the rate of 6% per annum until paid.

One note, dated July 1st, 1905, for \$120.00, due eight months after date thereof, with interest from date thereof at the rate of 6% per annum until paid.

One note, dated July 1st, 1905 for \$120.00, due twelve months after date thereof, with interest from date thereof at the rate of 6% per annum until paid. Now, If said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said parties of the second part, their heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described note mentioned, together with
