

Whereas, on or about the eleventh day of September A.D. 1900, John Black, of Douglas County, Kansas, for value received, made and delivered to The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, a Corporation of the State of Wisconsin, his certain promissory note bearing date on that day for the principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars, payable to the order of said Insurance Company, five (5) years from the date of the said note, and bearing interest at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of March and of September, in each ^{and every} year with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more of the principal sum of said note on any interest paying day after one (1) year from the date of the said note and before maturity, and at the same time the said John Black and Lucretia J. Black, his wife executed and delivered to the said Insurance Company a Mortgage, bearing even date with said note, upon certain real estate lying and being in the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, and more particularly described in the said mortgage, as security for the payment of said note, and which said Mortgage was recorded in the Register of Deeds office of the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, on the fourth day of October A.D. 1900, at eight o'clock A.M. in Volume 38 of Mortgages, on page 348. And whereas, no part of the said sum of two thousand (2000) dollars has been paid to the said Insurance Company on the principal of the said note and Mortgage, and the interest has been paid to the first day of September, 1905, and there remains unpaid on said note and Mortgage of the principal thereof the just and full sum of two thousand (2000) dollars, with interest thereon from the first day of September, 1905.

And Whereas, the said John Black, has requested the said Insurance Company to extend the time of payment of the said principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars, remaining unpaid on said note and Mortgage, until the eleventh day of September, A.D. 1910, with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more of said principal sum on any interest paying day after the eleventh day of September 1906, and before maturity, and the said Insurance Company has consented and agreed to make such extension as requested.
