

Confessed and acknowledged the said John Black, hereby agrees to and with The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, to pay interest on the said sum of two thousand (2000) dollars, being the principal sum remaining unpaid on said Note and Mortgage from the first day of September A.D. 1905, until paid, at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semiannually on the first day of March and of September in each ^{and every} year, and to pay the said principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars remaining unpaid on said Note and Mortgage, on the eleventh day of September, A.D. nineteen hundred and ten (1910), with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more of said principal sum on any interest paying day after the eleventh day of September A.D. nineteen hundred and six 1906, and before maturity. Both principal and interest payable at the office of the Insurance Company in the City of Milwaukee in the State of Wisconsin; and the said John Black and Lucretia J. Black, his wife, hereby Covenant and Agree, that said Mortgage shall continue and remain as security for the payment of said principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars remaining unpaid on said Note and Mortgage, and interest as hereinbefore stated, from the said first day of September 1905, until paid; and in case of default in payment of any installment of principal or interest at maturity, the provisions of said Note and Mortgage making ~~making~~ the principal sum due at the option of said Insurance Company shall be in force (notice of such option being hereby expressly waived); and the said Note and Mortgage and all their Covenants and Conditions shall remain in force except as modified by this Agreement.
