J. Saile; And Whereas, the name of the said F. J. Saile is Frank J. Saile;

And Whereas, the said Frank J. Saile is married, his wife's name being Mary Saile; And Whereas, the said Frank J. Saile has requested the said Insurance Company to extend the time of payment of the said balance of, twenty five hundred (2500) dollars, remaining unpaid on the principal of the third note above mentioned, until the eighth day of October A.D. nineteen hundred and ten (1910) with the privilege of paying five hundred (500) dollars, or more of said principal sum on any interest paying day after the date of this agreement and before maturity and the said Insurance Company has consented and agreed to make such extension as required; Now Therefore, in consideration of the premises, and of One Dollar to him in hand paid by The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, the said Frank J. Saile hereby agrees to and with The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, to pay interest on the said sum of twenty five hundred (2500) dollars, being the principal sum remaining unpaid on said notes and mortgage.
