

on the eighth day of October A.D. nineteen hundred and ten (1910) with the privilege of paying five hundred (500) dollars, or more, of said principal sum, on any interest paying day after the date of this agreement and before maturity, both principal and interest payable at the office of the said Insurance Company in the City of Milwaukee in the State of Wisconsin; and the said Frank J. Saile and Mary Saile, his wife hereby covenant and agree that said mortgage shall continue and remain as security for the payment of said principal sum of twenty five hundred (2500) dollars remaining unpaid on said notes and mortgage, and interest as hereinbefore stated, from the said first day of September 1905, until paid; and in case of default in payment of any installment of principal or interest at maturity, the provisions of said notes and mortgage making the principal sum due at the option of said Insurance Company shall be in force (notice of such option being hereby expressly waived); and the said notes and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as modified by this agreement.
