

Whereas, on or about the twenty second day of October A.D., 1900, Leonard R. Bryan, of Douglas County, Kansas, for value received, made and delivered to The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, a corporation of the State of Wisconsin, his certain promissory note bearing date on that day for the principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars, payable to the said order of said Insurance Company, five (5) years from the date of the said note, and bearing interest at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of April and of October in cash and every year with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more, if the principal sum of said note or any interest paying day after one (1) year from the date of the said note and before maturity, and at the same time the said Leonard R. Bryan and Sallie L. Bryan his wife, executed and delivered to the said Insurance Company a mortgage, bearing even date with said note, upon certain real estate lying and being in the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, and more particularly described in the said mortgage, as security for the payment of said note, and which said mortgage was recorded in the Register of Deeds office of the said County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, on the thirteenth day of November A.D. 1900 at eight o'clock A.M., in Volume 35 of Mortgages, on page 352, And Whereas, the sum of five hundred (500) dollars was paid to the said insurance company on the principal of the said note and mortgage on November 7th 1905, and the interest has been paid to the first day of October 1905, and there remains unpaid on said note and mortgage of the principal thereof, the just and full sum of fifteen hundred (1500) dollars, with interest from the first day of October 1905 to the ninth day of November 1905 on the sum of two thousand (2000) dollars and from the ninth day of November 1905 on the said sum of fifteen hundred (1500) dollars,
