

requested the said Insurance Company to extend the time of payment of the said balance of fifteen hundred dollars (1500) dollars remaining unpaid on the principal of said note and mortgage until the twenty second day of October A.D. nineteen hundred and ten (1910) with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more of said principal sum on any interest paying day after the date of this agreement and before maturity, and the said Insurance Company has consented and agreed to make such extension as requested.

Now Therefore, in consideration of the premises, and of One Dollar to him in hand paid by The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, the said Leonard R. Bryan hereby agrees to and with The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, to pay interest on the said sum of two thousand (2000) dollars from the first day of October A.D. 1905 to the ninth day of November A.D. 1905 and to pay interest on the said sum of fifteen hundred (1500) dollars being the principal sum remaining unpaid on said note and mortgage from the ninth day of November A.D. 1905, until paid at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semiannually on the first day of April and of October in each and every year, and to pay the said principal sum of fifteen hundred (1500) dollars remaining unpaid on said note and mortgage, on the twenty second day of October A.D. nineteen hundred and ten (1910) with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more, of said principal sum on any interest paying day after the date of this agreement and before maturity, both principal and interest payable at the office of the said Insurance Company in the City of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin, and The said Leonard R. Bryan and Sadie L. Bryan his wife, hereby covenant and agree that said mortgage shall continue and remain as security for the payment of said principal sum
