This Indenture, Made and executed this Twenty fifth day of November 1905 by James M. King and Fannie King Husband and Wife of Douglas County, Kansas, parties of the first part, and The Union Central Life Insurance Company, of Cincinnati, Ohio, party of the second part;

Witnesseth, That the said first parties for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars, paid by the said second party, its successors and assigns, for the certain tract or parcel of real estate, situated in Douglas County, Kansas, described as follows to wit: The South half of the North west quarter of section Ten (10) and the East Seventy (70) acres of the South half of the Northeast quarter of section Nine (9), all in Township Fifteen (15), Range Nineteen (19), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Containing One Hundred and Fifty (150) acres, more or less.

To Secure The Payment of a debt evidenced by certain promissory note of even date herewith, signed by James M. King and Fannie King of said first parties, and payable to said second party, more fully described as follows: One principal note for the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, (and being for the principal sum loaned), payable ten years after date (or in partial payments prior to maturity, in accordance with the stipulation therein) with interest at the rate therein specified and evidenced by coupon notes.
