

The Lawrence Water Company to United States Mortgage And Trust Company, Trustee, This Indenture made this 23rd day of November A.D. 1905 (but referred to in the bonds hereby secured as dated the first day of November 1905) between The Lawrence Water Company a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Maine hereinafter called the "Company" party of the first part and the United States Mortgage and Trust Company of New York a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York as Trustee hereinafter called the "Trustee" party of the second part. Witnesseth, Whereas the Company is by its charter duly authorized to purchase construct maintain and operate water works and gas works and electric light works in the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas with the right to issue bonds and secure the same by mortgage of its plant and property and franchises.

And Whereas the Company has been authorized by resolutions of its stockholders and its Board of Directors to issue its bonds to the amount of fifty thousand Dollars (\$50,000) payable in gold coin of the United States of America of the present standard or in its equivalent on the first day of November 1905 and bearing interest from the first day of November 1905 at the rate of five per centum per annum payable in like coin on the first day of May and the first day of November in each year until the principal sum is paid and to be redeemable after November 1, 1916 at one hundred and five per cent (105%) and accrued interest such bonds to be in denomination of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each and to be substantially in the form following to wit:
