of the Sum of Five Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I Fanny Bergmann of
Lawrence of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas do hereby
grant, bargain sell, assign and set over to Ralph Bergmann, of
Lawrence of the County of Douglas & State of Kansas a certain
Indenture of Mortgage, Executed by Robert W. Watt & Ida Watt,
of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas on the 29th day of January
A.D. 1902, to the said Fanny Bergmann, on the following described real
estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit:

Commencing 120 rods South of the N.E. corner of the N.W. fractional
1/4 of Section 6, Township 17, Range 19, thence West 106 2/3 rods; thence
