

All that certain gas pipe line known and designated as "Northern Trunk Line Number One" extending from its present southern terminus at a point near Altoona in Wilson County, Kansas, northwardly out of said county of Wilson and through the counties of Neosho, Allen, Anderson, Franklin, Douglas, Johnson and Wyandotte to Kansas City, Kansas, a distance of about one hundred and thirty seven miles, more or less, which pipe line is built of steel pipe sixteen inches in diameter and laid and fastened with rubber packer couplings.

The pipe line hereby conveyed being the first line of two parallel sixteen inch rubber packer trunk gas pipe lines and known respectively as "Northern Trunk Line Number One" and "Northern Trunk Line Number Two" together with all ten inch, eight inch, six inch and other size branch and gathering lines in Wilson County, Kansas belonging to and connected with "Northern Trunk Line Number One," being the one hereby conveyed, at or near its extreme southern terminus, and connecting Trunk Line with the "Knapp Wells" so called, together with the undivided one-half of all "crossovers" connecting the two said Trunk Lines with each other at divers points, together with so much of the several rights of way heretofore granted to The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipeline and Improvement Company and heretofore assigned by that company to the Pipe Line Company, as well be embodied within two lines each drawn eighteen inches distant east and west from and running parallel with the center of the said pipe line as the same is now laid and maintained.

Such land and rights of way as are situate in Wilson County, Kansas, being described as follows:-
