Grant from Alex. Blair (single) dated March 9, 1905, conveying a right of way over the West Half of South east Quarter, Section Sixteen Township Twenty-seven, Range Seventeen.

Grant from George W. Nelson and wife and Wirt Nelson and wife, dated April 11, 1905, conveying a right of way over the North Half of Northwest Quarter of Section Fifteen, Township Twenty-seven Range Seventeen, and Northeast Quarter of Section Sixteen Township Twenty-seven Range Seventeen.

Grant from A. P. Ekson and Louisa Ekson by Joseph Ekson, her guardian, dated March 10, 1905, conveying a right of way over the South Half of Northeast Quarter of Section Ten, also North Half of South east Quarter of Section Ten, also Southeast Quarter of Section Ten, Township Twenty-seven, Range Seventeen.

Grant from James F. Hardy and wife, dated April 18, 1905, conveying a right of way over the North Half of Southeast Quarter of Section Fifteen Township Twenty-nine, Range Sixteen.

Grant from Charlotte Hagstrom and O. Hagstrom her husband, dated March 9, 1905, conveying a right of way over the North east Quarter of Section Thirty, Township Twenty-seven Range Seventeen, Neosho County.
