

Grant from James M^c Carr (widow) dated February 27, 1905, conveying a right of way over the West thirty five acres of Northeast Quarter of Section Eleven Township Fourteen Range Twenty-two, across North west corner of said land.

Grant from Margaret Effinger (single) dated February 25, 1905, conveying a right of way over ninety acres in the Southwest Quarter, Section Twenty-nine, Township Thirteen, Range Twenty-three.
