This Mortgage, made this 14th day of March in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six by and between C. W. Allendorph, and Martha S. Allendorph, his wife of the County of Jackson and State of Missouri party of the first part and A. S. Allendorph party of the second part. Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten hundred and twenty four (1024) Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all of the following described tract, piece, and parcel of land lying, laid, situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: All of the South half of Lot one hundred and three (103) in Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County Kansas. To have and to hold the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever; provided always, and this instrument is made, executed, and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Whereas, C. W. Allendorph and Martha S. Allendorph his wife the said party of the first part have this day made, executed and delivered to the said party of the second part their Promissory Note of even date herewith, by which they promise to pay to the said A. S. Allendorph or order for value received Ten hundred and twenty four (1024) ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars; due March 14th 1907, with interest from date to maturity at the rate of seven per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, as evidenced by six interest coupon notes of even date therewith and attached thereto, for the sum of \$ 35.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ each, falling due on the 14th days of September and March in each year; both principal and interest notes are payable at Kansas City, Missouri and bear interest from maturity until paid at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually.
