This Indenture, Made this Tenth day of September, in the year of our Lord, Nineteen hundred and two, between Mrs Sarah A. Frederick, widow of Benjamin A. Frederick, of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hon. T. Sinclair of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said part of of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.) Dollars,

to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The south east quarter of section No. Thirteen (13), in Township No. Thirteen (13), South, of Range No. Eighteen (18), East of the 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian,

Paid party of the first part agrees to maintain insurance for the benefit of the party of the second part, during the existence of this mortgage, to the amount of Two Thousand Dollars, upon the buildings upon said land,

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of of the first part therein. And the said

Mrs Sarah A. Frederick doth hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that she will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said second party, his heirs and assigns forever against all persons lawfully claiming same. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars,

according to the terms of One certain Mortgage Note this day executed and delivered by the said party of the first part to the said part of of the second part due in five years from date, with interest from date to maturity at a rate of six per cent. per annum until fully paid in cash or by Sheriff's Deed to above described property. and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. (But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the surplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said party of the first part, her heirs and assigns.
