MORTGAGE STANDARD FORM
This Indenture, Made this Eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord, Nineteen hundred
and two, between Samuel W. Nye and Olive G. Nye, his wife, of Lawrence in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hon. G. Sinclair, of the same place,
of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Twenty-five Hundred (\$2500) Dollars,

to me duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The west one-half of the south-west quarter of section Two (2), and the east one-half of the south-east quarter of section No. Three (3), all in Township No. Fourteen (14), South, of Range No. Twenty (20), East of the 6th P. M.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Samuel W. Nyg and Oliver F. Nyg do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner(s) of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said second party, his heirs and assigns forever against all persons lawfully claiming. This Grant is made as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars according to the terms of One certain Mortgage Note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said part of the second part due in five years from date, with interest from date to maturity, as evidenced by coupons attached thereto, and unless paid after maturity or default at the rate of ten per cent per annum until fully paid in cash or by Writing Deed to the above described property, and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of the first part, to his heirs and assigns.
