This Indenture, Made this First day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and two (1902), between Frederick Detcher and Julia A. Detcher, his wife, of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and E. M. Becker, of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point eighty-eight (88) feet west and one hundred (100) feet north of the south east corner of the north east quarter of section thirty (30) in township twelve (12) south and range twenty (20) east. Thence west eighty (80) feet thence north one hundred (100) feet, thence east eighty (80) feet thence south one hundred (100) feet to the place of beginning, being in addition six (6) in that part of the City of Lawrence, known as North Lawrence.

In consideration of full payment of the within mortgage I hereby release the same this 23rd day of Oct 1902.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Frederick Detcher and Julia A. Detcher, his wife, do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances. This mortgage being given to correct an error in the description of the above described land which mortgage is recorded in Book Thirty-nine (39) on page 211 of the records of Douglas County. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred Dollars.

According to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Frederick Detcher and Julia A. Detcher to the said party of the second part and reads as follows— Lawrence, Kas., July 1st 1902— Beware before I pay date for value received, my promise to pay E. M. Becker or his/her/able heirs and assigns the sum of Two hundred dollars in monthly payments of Four each month beginning Aug 1st 1902 until the two hundred dollars is fully paid with interest at Four percent per annum after date payable and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the parties of the first part or their heirs and assigns.
